Stay and Play is a wonderful way to provide young children with an opportunity to interact with other children in a safe, loving environment. Our day includes large motor time, snack time, sensory play, music, stories, and arts & crafts. **Students using Stay and Play must be 1 year old and solidly walking.**

Stay and Play tuition and fees: Because Stay and Play is designed to be a flexible program, we have different options for tuition, based on desired use.

Single-day use:

\$5 for Before School Care Only (8:45-9:20)

\$25 for Stay and Play morning (9:20-11:50)

Regular use: An enrollment fee of \$25 is due at the time of reservation.

Regular before school care for students in a preschool or stay and play class: If you would like early drop-off (8:45) each day that your child attends class, a monthly fee will be added to your tuition amount, based on your child's number of class days (\$20/month for 1-day, \$40/month for 2-day, \$60/month for 3-day, and \$80/month for 5-day).

Stay and Play Enrichment Fees (regular reservation for 9:20-11:50)

1-day per week: \$ 80.00 monthly tuition

2-days per week: \$145.00 monthly tuition

3-days per week: \$205.00 monthly tuition

(**If using Stay and Play more than 3 days per week, a tuition amount will be determined on an individual basis).

Stay & Play payment information: Stay and Play tuition will be due by the 10th of each month, along with regular preschool tuition. Stay and play and regular tuition payments may be combined in one check. **If using Stay and Play for single-day use, please pay for the day when you arrive.**

When using Stay & Play, we ask that you make sure to bring a diaper bag/backpack to include diapers, wipes, and a change of clothes for your child, as well as a filled water cup for snack time. ***Please label everything clearly with your child's name.***

We also ask that if you are utilizing this program regularly you help us provide snack with an occasional donation. Please bring in a sealed community snack (cereal, cereal bars, crackers, cheese, applesauce, etc). NO POPCORN PLEASE.
